Item S-53.2023-II-1.7: Release of Teaching Assistantship for PhD Scholars beyond three years in steps of six months for a maximum period of 5 years

As per PhD ordinance 2016 (including all subsequent amendments), application for extension of teaching assistantship beyond three years may be considered only if the candidate (Research Scholar) publishes one SCI/SCIE/SSCI (Q1 & Q2) Journal paper or two Scopus papers in Q1 journals as first author at the time of submitting application for further extension.

In case the Research Scholar could not publish the paper in three years duration, the teaching assistantship of the research scholar may be released with due recommendation of DRPC and Dean Academic in steps of six months maximum up to 5 years (as per MHRD letter F.No.17-2/2014-T.S.-I dated 1st September, 2015) or up to the date of thesis submission, which ever falls earlier. In this case, the Supervisor(s), DRPC members and HoD must ensure that the work of the research scholar is sufficient to release the teaching assistantship of the recommended period without any paper publication before forwarding the recommendation/ SRPC progress report to Dean Academician the prescribed format with detailed plan of action for next six months. However, the requirement of two SCI/SCIE/SSCI (Q1 & Q2) Journal papers for thesis submission shall be strictly followed. This was approved by the Chairman Senate.

Decision: Ratified, with a slight change in the order, that is, in place of DRPC it will be read as “the SRPC of the candidate must ensure that the work of the research scholar is sufficient to release the teaching Assistantship of the recommended period without any paper publication”. All other conditions shall remain same.



Item S-53.2023-II-2.3: Proposal for Part-Time all Post Graduate Courses & Part-Time Ph.D. Programme in all disciplines

The current job market demands higher degrees in all fields of education. Considering the competitive situation in India as well as abroad, Part-time programs are designed specifically for individuals who aim to pursue advanced education without disrupting their professional lives. Part-time programs provide the flexibility to study as per their convenience, allowing to attend classes and engage in coursework while continuing job responsibilities. The part-time postgraduate program offers a diverse range of disciplines and specializations, allowing to choose the area of study that aligns with one's professional goals and interests. Presently, MANIT Bhopal offers 33 full-time post graduate program like M.Tech. in various disciplines, M.Plan, MBA, MCA, and M.Sc. The Institute is now proposing the part-time post graduate program for all the full time existing post graduate programs.

a. Part-time Post Graduate Course Structure:

The minimum duration of part-time post graduate program will be (M.Tech./MBA/M.Sc./M.Plan) 6 semester (3 years) and for MCA the duration will be 4 years (8 semesters). The scheme and syllabus for all the above Part- Time courses will be designed by the concerned departments if the proposal is approved.

b. Part Time Ph.D. programs:

It is also proposed that Part Time Ph.D. program may be started in all the departments so that the interested working professionals / teachers may be able to pursue part time Ph.D. in their area of interest. The rules and regulation for this programme will be applicable as per MOE/UGC/AICTE guidelines. If the proposal is approved, concerned department will provide the information regarding mandatory requirement of residency, No. of Seats, details of course work offered to part-time Ph.D. candidates and criterion of eligibility (if any) in addition to the established guidelines.

Item S-53.2023-II-2.4: Self-Sponsored M Tech/ M Plan Full Time

Declining trend in the admissions of students in M Tech/ M Plan., programs throughout the country is seen as an alarming situation. On the other hand there are a number of enquiries of aspirants seeking admissions in M Tech/ M Plan programs in Institutes of National Importance. MANIT Bhopal has also witnessed the similar situation of declining trend in the admissions of students in M Tech Programs.

In the light of the above fact and in order to mobilize the available resources with the Institute it is proposed that direct admissions to aspirants seeking admissions in M Tech/ M Plan., programs of MANIT Bhopal may be advertised. In this category GATE qualified (any time), valid GATE Score and Non-GATE qualified candidate may be allowed to participate. The detailed proposal in this regard is being placed before Senate for approval.

Item S-53.2023-II-2.5: Re-registration of Ph.D. Scholar after 07 years as maximum duration permitted





As per 51st Senate meeting held on 22-11-2022, Item No. S-51.2022-III-2.10 "Amendments in Ph.D. Ordinance"

"The Bachelor students (B.Tech/ B.Arch/ B.Plan/ Equivalent Degree) with 8.5 CGPA or above without GATE score from Institute of National Importance (IIT/ IIIT / NIT) are also promoted to take direct admission to Ph.D. program from December 2022 session onwards. It is proposed that



if such candidates are selected in the Ph.D. program, they may also be entitled for the teaching assistantship at par with GATE qualified regular research scholars”. The decision of Senate in this matter is as follows “Senate has recommended for teaching assistantship at par with GATE qualified research scholar for the approval of FC & BOG, before implementation.”

Members discussed the matter in detail and FC directed that admission of non-GATE students be discussed again in the Senate in line with other NITs/IITs and put up for consideration in the next meeting.

Further, FC advised that, in place of Teaching Assistantship, the nomenclature should be used as Fellowship/Scholarship for the any financial benefits.

Decision: A committee is to be constituted to study the implementation and submit its recommendation in the next Senate meeting.

Item S-53.2023-II-2.10: Matter of UFM Cases: i. Anand Kumar (191114086), ii. BollamVikranth Reddy (211114013) in MOM of UFM Committee dated 18-05-2023

The above two students of ECE department were booked under UFM category. During the meeting of UFM committee dated 18-05-2023, the I/c Head, ECE has submitted and commented that “the student has by mistake carried the mobile phone in his pocket, he may be exempted from any punishment” though the UFM committee has taken the cognizance of the comments of I/c Head (ECE), the PIC(Exam) and Dean (Academic) in their comments referred to the “UG Ordinance 2016” UNFAIR MEANS (UFM) Rule, Point 11, category F which states that “keeping / using mobile at the time of examination”, recommends cancellation of paper. When the matter is placed before Chairman, Senate, he has directed to place the matter in Senate for discussion and decision.

Decision: The punishment of cancellation of subject paper and award of F grade to both the students is endorsed by the senate. However, the Senate members also approved for conduction of early supplementary exams for VIII semester students.

Item S-53.2023-II-2.11: Request of MBA Students 2021-2023 Batch for Endorsement of Specialization in MBA Degree

The specialization of the students has not been mentioned anywhere in the degree or the mark sheet. This is likely to lead to a serious void in my documentation, as students were granted study leave specifically for MBA (HR Management) by the Indian Army. However, it is also likely to lead to problem for other students as well; who apply for jobs based on specific specialization criteria. Students requested that the MBA specialization may please be mentioned in the final degree that will be issued to us.

This enables the students to explore more and more relevant courses of Industry requirement as per their convenience and availability. In the light of the above, it is proposed that all VIII semester students of B.Tech all branches may be permitted to join classes in online mode while doing mandatory projects/ internship in industries/ organization or otherwise as per the prevailing scheme. They are exempted to attend classes in physical mode.

They may take only two courses from NPTEL with a choice that they may appear in the exams conducted by the Institute or conducted by the NPTEL.

The classes of other subjects as per scheme will be conducted by the Institute in online mode.

However, Examination (Continuous Evaluation, Project Assessment and End Term Examination) as per schedule will be conducted in offline mode. Students have to appear physically in the exams except for the two NPTEL courses, if they opt for examination to be conducted by NPTEL.

Decision: The existing scheme is to be followed for this session (2023-24) however concerned department have to prepare the revised scheme which shall be applicable from the next session (2024-25) onwards after the approval of competent authority.
