Response: "Lok Sabha question Dy. No. 643 "Measures to curb drug addiction"

To effectively curb drug addiction through the Institute education curriculum, a combination of preventive education, policy enforcement and student engagement is embedded into both academic and extracurricular activities. Already, important measures are put into practice:

1. Curriculum Integration

- **Health and Wellness Seminars:** Conduct Lectures/workshops/seminars focusing on curb drug addiction awareness.
- One subject/course is running for Life skill management for students to teach stress management, conflict resolution, and emotional intelligence to reduce the triggers of drug use.

2. Peer Education and Mentoring

- **Peer Educator Programs:** Train senior students to educate their juniors about the risks of drug use and healthy alternatives.
- There is a scheme of Tutor Guardian. In this scheme, one faculty member is act as his/her local guardian and discusses his/her problems.

3. Counseling and Support Services

• Accessible Counseling: Institute employs counselor to provide on campus mental health support, including confidential, substance abuse counseling.

Further, to effectively curb drug addiction through the Institute education curriculum, a combination of preventive education, policy enforcement and student engagement should be embedded into both academic and extracurricular activities. **Important measures that can be put into practice:**

1. Curriculum Integration

- Curb Drug Addiction Education Courses: Include some modules on substance abuse
- **Health and Wellness Seminars:** Conduct Lectures/workshops/seminars focusing on curb drug addiction awareness
- Community Outreach: Collaborate with NGOs, health professionals, and law enforcement for integrated campaigns and interventions.
