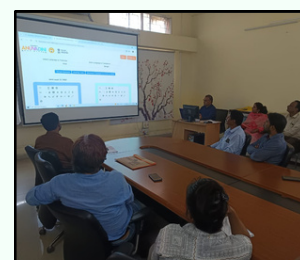
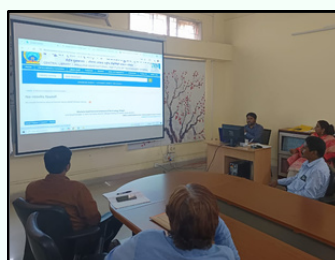

Architecture Students' Visit

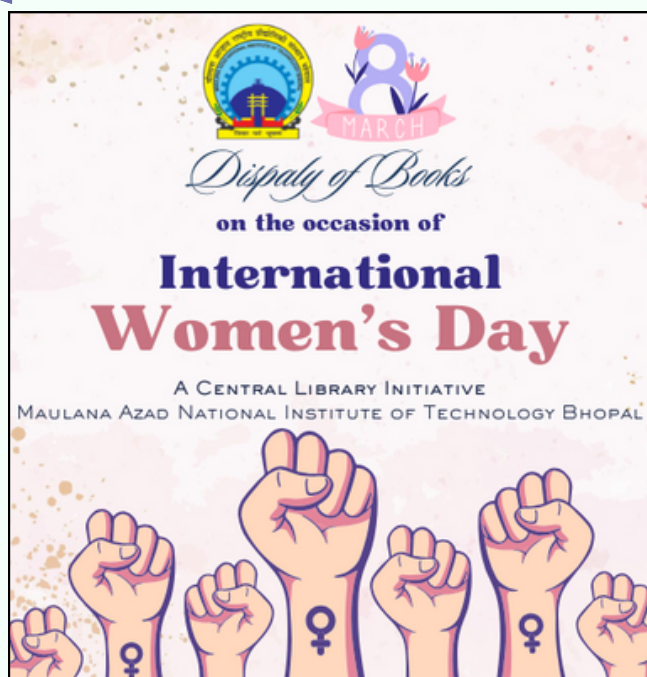


During their visit to the Library, a brief presentation was made about the the Central Library and its services. The Faculty from the University also shared their experience on designing new library spaces.

External Activities – Session at IPE Hyderabad



On an invitation from the Institute of Public Enterprise (IPE), Hyderabad, Dr Venkata Rao Pokuri, Librarian & Head, Central Library Bhopal conducted a session on 'Information Retrieval with AI – Use of AI Search Tools' during a two-day National Workshop on 'Impact of AI on Library and Information Work'. The workshop was organised by the Institute of Public Enterprise (IPE) on 03-04 April 2025 Shamirpet Campus, Hyderabad. A total of 45 librarians and library teachers from diverse academic backgrounds and institutions participated in the workshop.



During the session Dr Rao demonstrated various AI based search and explained with examples of AI-powered information retrieval, such as Diksha for ticket booking, and institutional chatbots for student communication. Also covered AI tools for research, automation, summarization, and citation generation, including elicitor.com, evidencehunt.com, inciteful.xyz, research rabbit, scrite.ai, bit.ai, semanticscholar.org, scispace, etc.

External Activities – Session at AASC Assam



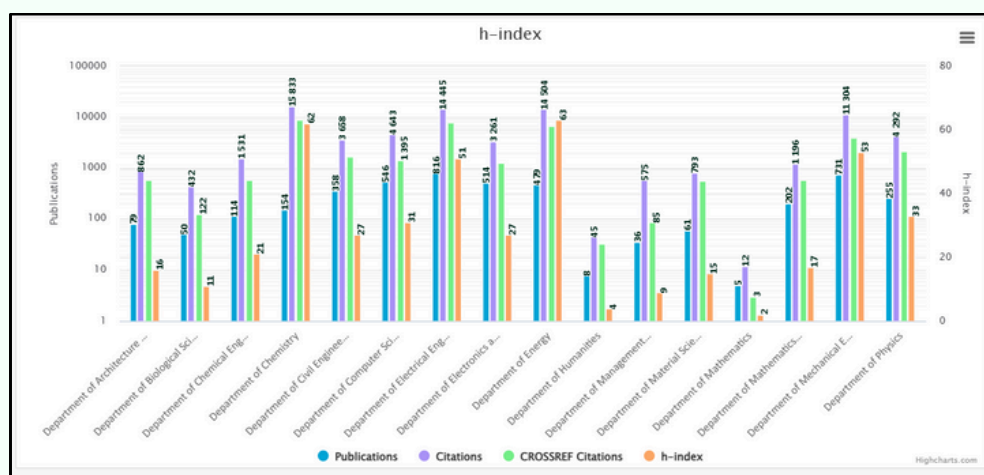
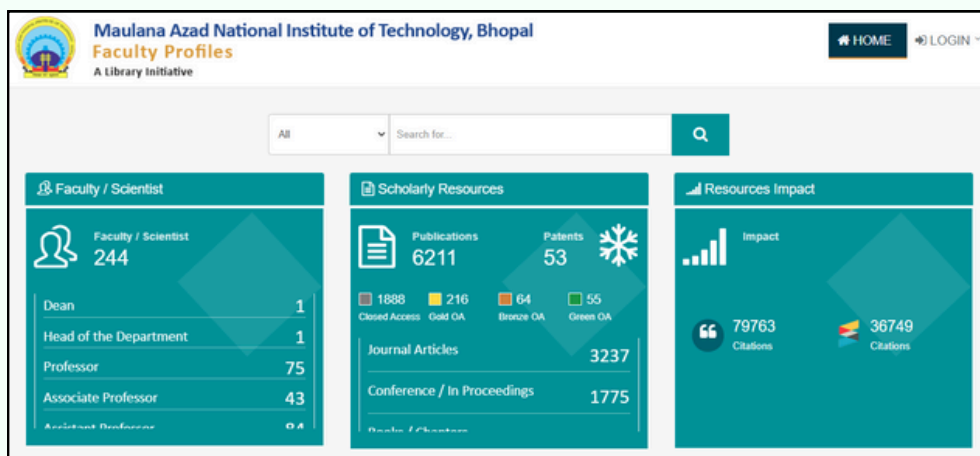
Dr. Venkata Rao Pokuri, Librarian & Head, Central Library, MANIT Bhopal conducted a training session on "Open Access Resources and Artificial Intelligence tools for Bureaucrats" for officer trainees – Assam Civil Service and Assam Police Service on 12th March 2025 at Guwahati. Dr Rao was invited by the Director (Training), Assam Administrative Staff College, Guwahati. The session was attended by 77 off-

icer trainees. Dr. Rao described various artificial intelligence tools and their usage in day-to-day administration and provided various open access resources in governance, management and administration for the benefit of officer trainees. The session was a part of a two-week Induction Training Programme for the officers of Assam Civil Service & Assam Police Service, 2025 Batch was organized by the Assam Administrative Staff College, Guwahati from 3rd to 15th March 2025.

- **Institutional Digital Repository:** a reservoir of the different types of institutional documents to be archived in one single portal.
- **Library Website:** a separate website for the library for updates and information from the library at your fingertips more frequently.
- **INFED:** a standard-based open source software, for authenticating authorized users from and provide them seamless access to e-resources from anywhere, anytime.

FACILITIES

- **QR code based library entry/exit system:** a unique digital entry/exit register system replacing the traditional print register. This will also help us to track the user footprints in the library.
- **SMS Service:** SMS to the library members for all library circulation related transactions like; issue, return, renew etc. for their easy reference purposes.

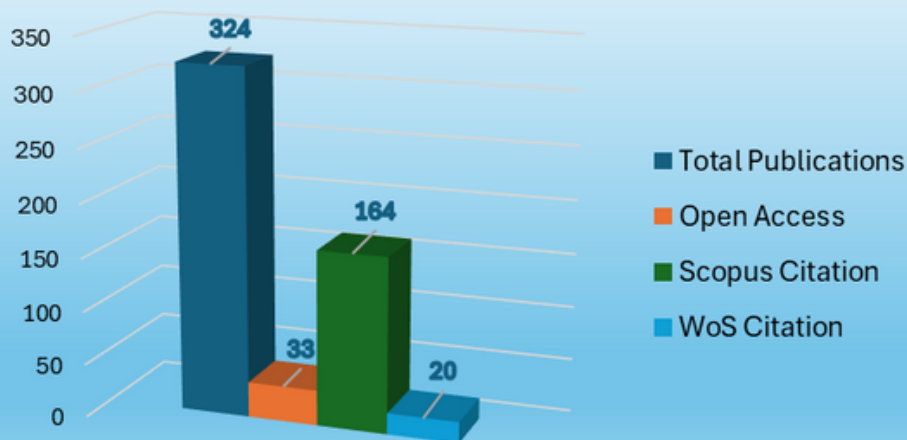

MANIT Bhopal Publications



The MANIT Bhopal's growth rate is on steadfast in terms of research and publications. A total of 189 papers has been published by the MANIT Bhopal community during February - April 2025. With this, the total number of publications stood at 324 during the current year. The citations received across the platforms -164 with self-citation and 112 without self citation from Scopus and 20 with self-citation and 15 without self-citation from Web of Science.

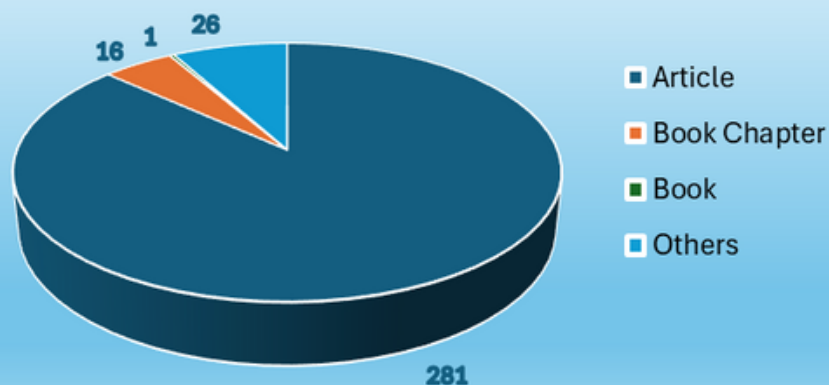
Out of 324 papers, 33 (more than 10%) papers are open-access (gold, hybrid and green) in nature.

A total of 281 articles (86%), 16 book chapters, 1 book and 26 other materials were published out of 324 publications.

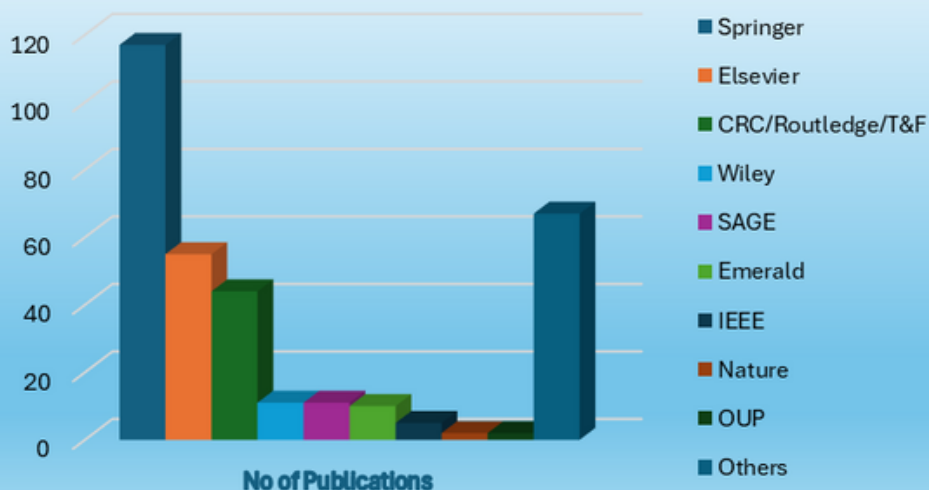
Springer was the most preferred publication house (more than 36%), out of 324 publications, followed by Elsevier (16%), CRC/Routledge/Taylor & Francis (13%), Wiley, SAGE, Emerald, IEEE, Nature, OUP and other publication houses were there.

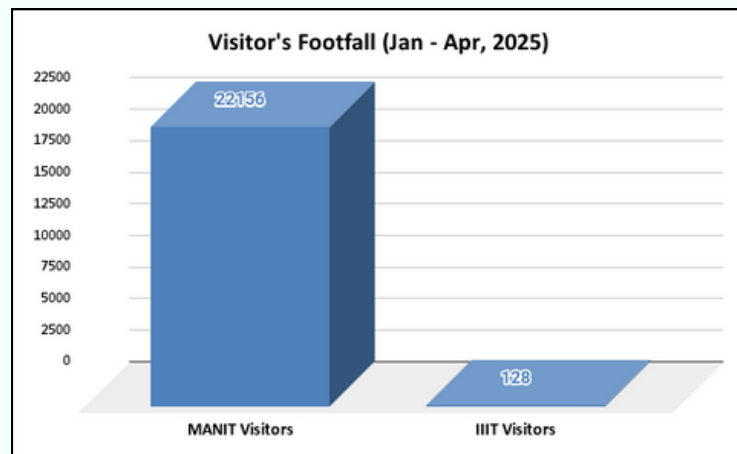
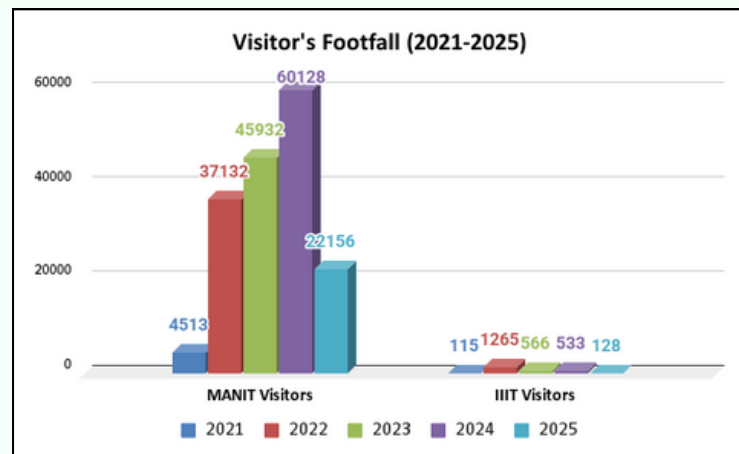

Library Statistics

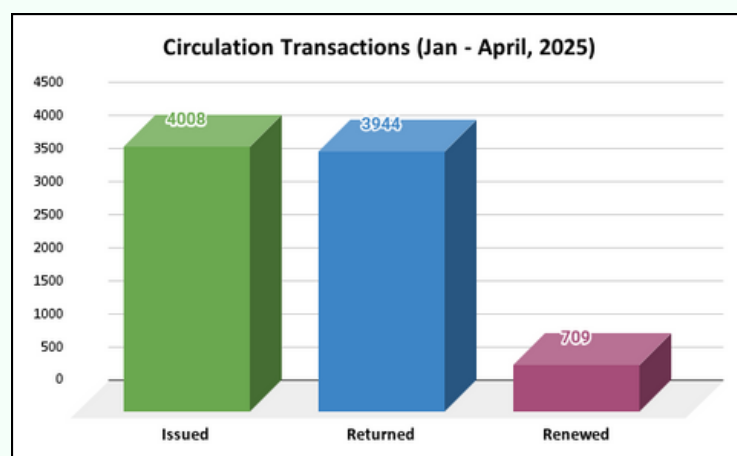
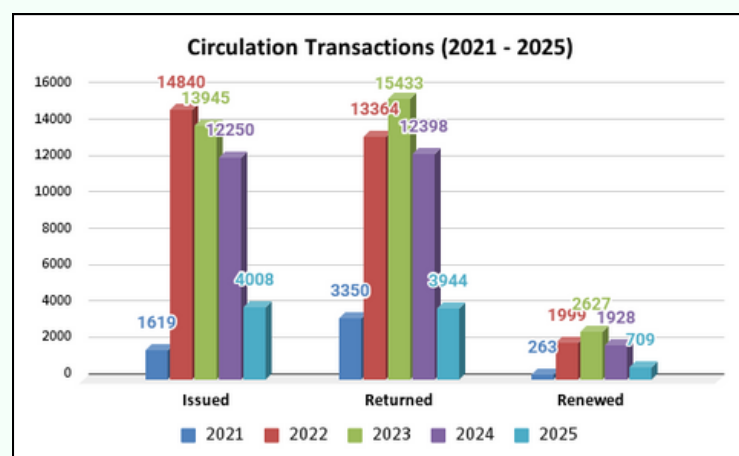


The Central Library is evolving with an ample growth rate. Based on the following statistical data points, the highlights are:

The Central Library was visited by a total of 4513, 37132, 45932 & 60128 during the years 2021-2024 respectively. The 2025 data shows that the library was visited by 228 visitors (average) on a daily basis. The Central Library has visitors from the IIIT Bhopal as well.

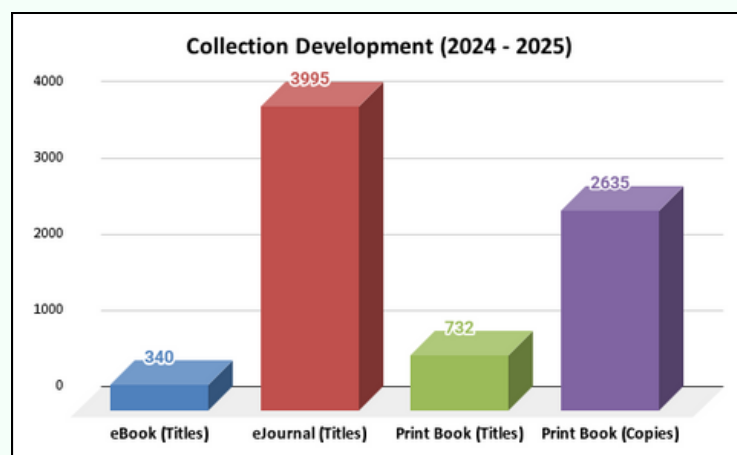
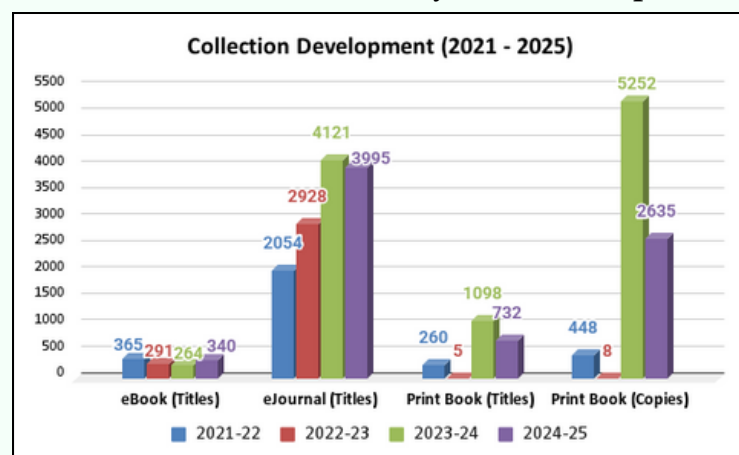


The Central Library issued a total number of 1619, 14840, 13945 & 12250 books in the year 2021-2024 respectively. Whereas 3350, 13364, 15433 & 12398 books were returned and 263, 1999, 2627, & 1928 books were renewed during the same period. The 2025 data shows 41 books were issued, 41 books were returned and 7 books were renewed on a daily basis (average).



In the financial year 2024-2025, 340 eBooks, 3995 e-Journals and 2635 copies of print books were purchased (732 individual titles out of 2635 copies of print books). Apart from the 2024-25 data, last three year data is also visualized here.

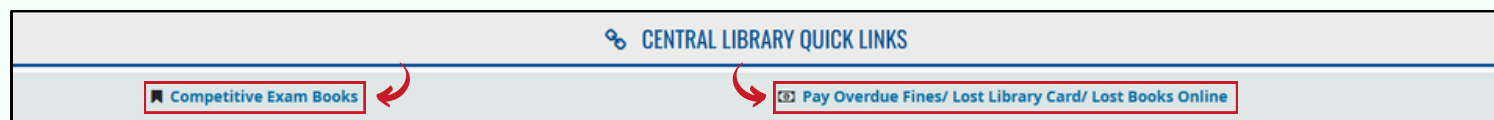


Advanced Features of Library e-Catalogue

The Central Library has added some new features in the e-Catalogue to make it more useful for the members.

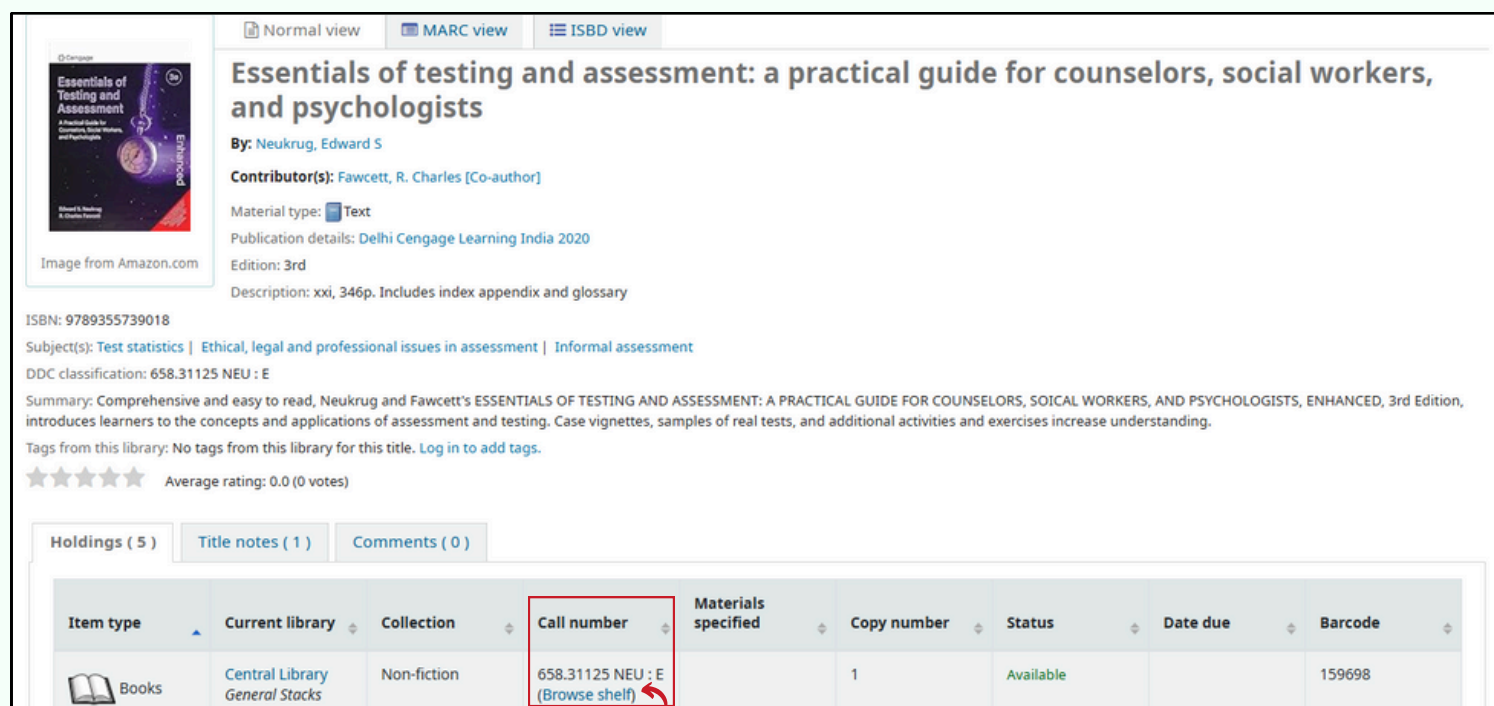
1. Quick Links.

Direct link to the collection of Competitive Books and pay fine option for books overdue/ lost library card/ lost of books (if you are paying via this link from outside the library, you need to send the pdf copy of the transaction on the same to to update the record in your library account).



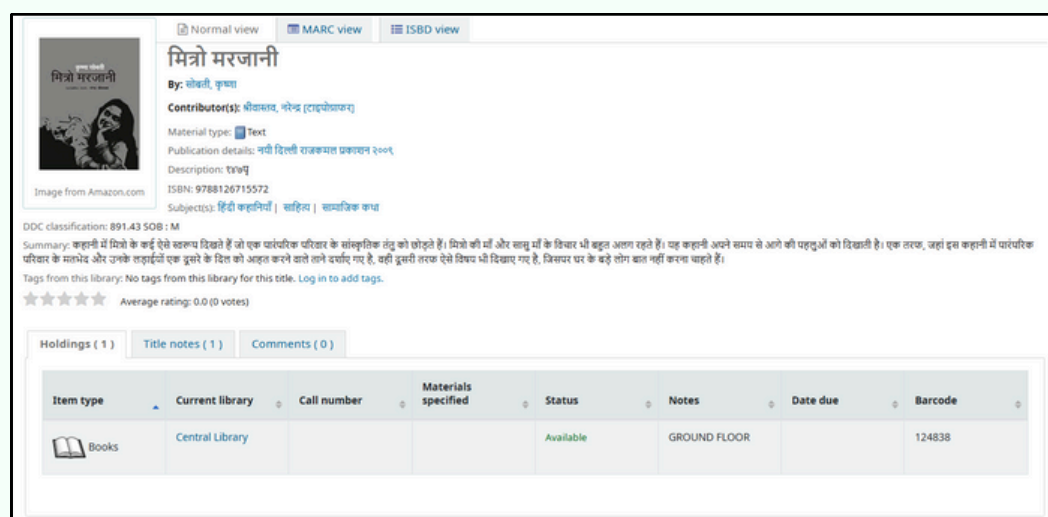
2. More detailed catalogue entry.

Catalogue entries have been made more details so that the members can identify the right reading materials, especially the Call No. , which is a specific identifier to get to the book more easily and specifically in the shelves. It also identifies related books on the topic.



3. Hindi Collection Separated.

For promoting Hindi Rajbhasha, Hindi language collection has been separated in the advance search section. The details of these books have been entered in Hindi language as well.



The library also created a column for the thesis submitted by the MANIT Bhopal research scholars. All the theses can be found at the advance search section by selecting and searching the thesis option. The full text link is also provided under individual thesis.
